Introduction

The fitness to practise team is responsible for the management of registration appeals. This paper is intended to provide the Education and Training Committee with an update on the numbers of registration appeals.

Background information

- Hearings were held on
 - September 9, 10, 15, 21
- 30 cases will be heard on the following dates in October
 - October 1, 5, 22, 27
- 24 cases will be heard on the following dates in November
 - November 8, 18
- Dates have been provisionally set for further cases to be heard in December, January and February
- A total of 67 cases have been withdrawn either by HPC or the appellant. Reasons include:
 - No right to appeal as decision was against TOC
 - Grounds not received within 28 days
 - Appellant wishes to re-apply
- Of the 70 hearings that have been held
 - 1 UK appeal has been allowed
 - 33 International appeals have been allowed
 - 4 Grandparenting appeals have been allowed

- 12 International appeals have been dismissed
- 1 Grandparenting appeal has been dismissed

Resource implications

The Fitness to Practise team currently has an International Registration on secondment for three months to assist in managing registration appeals
