Reasons
<p>The Panel accepted the visitor’s recommendation that the education provider and its programmes remain approved, for the reasons noted below.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Following documentary review and quality activity, the visitors were satisfied with the overall performance of the education provider across the themes. • The education provider had responded to recommendations from external regulators and professional bodies. • The education provider had progressed service user and carer engagement in the programme. <p>They also agreed with the visitors’ recommended monitoring period, for the reason noted below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the lack of established data points for the education provider, without which an ongoing monitoring period of over two years could not be approved. <p>The panel noted the ongoing work with the education provider to embed established data points and to produce usable data ahead of the next performance review.</p>
