BULLET POINTS FOR INTERIM ORDERS

- All parties will introduce themselves
- The Solicitor for the HPC will present the case
- The registrant will then present their case.
- The decision for the panel is whether the allegation is of such a serious nature that the following grounds need to be satisfied
 - Protection of members of the public
 - Otherwise in the public interest
 - In the interests of the person concerned
- The panel can either impose an interim suspension order or an interim conditions of practice order
- When consider whether an interim conditions of practice order the panel should not impose conditions which are of a final disposal nature, but have in mind what type of conditions can satisfy the above grounds
- The order can be imposed for a maximum period of 18 months and if the case hasn't been disposed of at a final hearing will need to reviewed at 6 months and then at 3 monthly intervals thereafter.
- Use the legal assessor to assist you in the drafting
